Popular Photoshop Keyboard Shortcuts for Windows

Select All – Control A

Deselect All – Control D

Save - Control S

Save As – Shift Control S

Zoom In – Control + (plus)

Zoom Out – Control – (minus)

Fit In Screen – Control 0 (zero)

Copy – Control C

Paste – Control V

Hand Tool While In Any Tool – Spacebar

Undo – Control Z

Default Foreground And Background Colors – D (Black and White)

Switch The Foreground And Background Colors – X

Fill Dialog Box – Shift Backspace

Eye Dropper With Any Painting Tool – Alt

Transform – Control T

Selections and Brushes

Add To A Selection – Shift and drag

Subtract From A Selection – Alt and drag

Select The Intersection Of Two Selections – Shift Alt and drag

Invert a Selection – Shift Control I

Constrain A Selection To A Square Or Circle – Shift and drag

Draw a Selection From The Center – Alt and drag

Constrain A Selection To A Square Or Circle And Draw From The Center – Shift Alt and drag

See The Width Of The Magnetic Lasso Tool - press the cap lock key on the keyboard.

Change The Width Of The Magnetic Lasso Tool While Drawing – Bracket Keys “[” or”]”

Change The Contrast Of The Magnetic Lasso Tool While Drawing - use the period key “.” to increase the contrast (if your image is high contrast), and use the comma “,” key to decrease the contrast slider (if your image is low contrast).

Delete Nodes While Using The Magnetic Lasso Tool - Delete

Start Over With A Selection - Esc

Change The Brush Size - Hold Alt Control and right click then drag left and right or Use the Bracket Keys “[” or”]”

Change The Brush Hardness - Hold Alt Control and right click and drag up or down, or use shift “[” or”]” to change the hardness in 25% increments

Move Selection 1 Pixel – With any selection tool selected, use the arrow keys to move 1 pixel. Press the Shift with the arrow keys to move 10 pixels

Move Selected Area 1 Pixel - With the Move tool selected, use the arrow keys to move 1 pixel. Press the Shift with the arrow keys to move 10 pixels

Layer Panel

Merge Down – Control E

Clip A Layer To The Layer Below – Alt Click the line below the layer you want to clip

Rename A Layer – Double click on the layer name

Merge All Layers Into One Copy Layer – Shift Control Alt E

Load Layer Transparency As A Selection – Control Click the Layer Thumbnail

Copy a Layer Mask From One Layer To Another – Alt Drag the layer mask

Turn Off The Visibility Of A Layer Mask – Shift Click on the layer mask

Load A Layer Mask As A Selection – Alt Click on the layer mask

Type

Select A Word – Double Click on the word

Select A Line – Triple Click on the line.

Select A Paragraph – Click four times in the paragraph
